MORE INFORMATION

Our group will be leaving the Stillaguamish Community Center on Tuesday, April 4th at 9am. We are scheduled to return on Friday April 7th at 5pm.

While at EWU, we will be staying in a standard dormitory hall where students will room in groups of 2, unless a single room is requested. Please bring any personal items you will need for a three-night stay, including clean clothes, toiletries, chargers for cell phones/laptops, etc. Linens will be provided.

Students will each receive a campus meal card pre-loaded with a dollar amount (\$10/breakfast, \$15/lunch, \$15/dinner). With the exception of a meal or two that will be eaten off campus, this will be how each student will purchase their food for the entirety of the trip. Please budget wisely and keep your card in a safe place so it doesn't get lost!
